

CREWS TO BEGIN WORK At Faraday Avenue and El Camino Real in October

Construction crews are making significant progress on the 10-mile Carlsbad Desalination Project pipeline in the Carlsbad Research Center. Crews are moving east along the route on Faraday Avenue and pipeline installation is scheduled to reach El Camino Real in October.

In order to maintain access and traffic flow throughout construction, crews will be tunneling under the intersection of El Camino Real and Faraday Avenue. Traffic on Faraday Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction on the north side of the street. During that time, the left-turn lanes onto Faraday from El Camino Real in both directions will be reduced to one lane. To avoid potential traffic impacts, drivers from northbound El Camino Real are encouraged to reach westbound Faraday Avenue via Salk Avenue and eastbound Faraday Avenue via Orion. Drivers traveling southbound on El Camino Real should access westbound Faraday Avenue via College Boulevard or Salk Avenue and eastbound Faraday Avenue via u-turn at the El Camino Real/Cougar Drive intersection. Construction will begin in early October and continue through December.

Every effort will be taken to minimize impacts to surrounding communities during construction. Vehicle traffic and access to nearby businesses is being maintained throughout pipeline installation.
